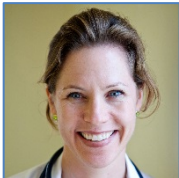

Physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, pharmacists, health educators, and other clinicians and public health professionals interested in immunization and communicable disease.

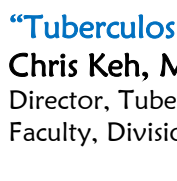

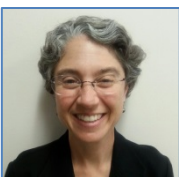
