You did it!! As a result of your hard work and dedication, an estimated 35,000 adolescents in San Francisco have been vaccinated with Tdap in response to AB354. This was a huge and unprecedented undertaking. Congratulations to everyone on your team – on OUR team!

REMEMBER! All schools must submit their Tdap report by **December 1, 2011**. Please visit www.shotsforschool.org to access log-in, instructions, and FAQs. Each school's immunization rates will be posted for public review.

MIDDLE SCHOOLS: Next year, and every school year thereafter, all 7th grade students will need to show proof of Tdap vaccination. Let's keep the momentum going strong by following these simple steps:

- ✓ Communicate the following messages to parents and students,
 - Check with your or your child's doctor to find out if he/she has already been vaccinated with Tdap; if so, obtain his/her record of the Tdap shot and bring it to school. If not, set up an appointment to get vaccinated with Tdap
 - Bring your immunization record to school
- ✓ Post information on your school's website
